

# BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

## DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA

T U E S D A Y, June 10, 2014

The Board was convened today at 9:01 a.m. and called to order by Chair Borgeson in the Legislative Chambers of the Omaha-Douglas Civic Center, 1819 Farnam Street, Omaha, NE. Advance notice of this publicly convened meeting was published in the Daily Record on May 30, 2014, and simultaneously transmitted to all members of the Board of Equalization. Said notice contained the time and place of the meeting. Commissioners Clare Duda, Marc Kraft, P. J. Morgan, Chris Rodgers, Pam Tusa and Mary Ann Borgeson were present. Commissioner Michael Boyle was absent. Commissioner Borgeson stated that a copy of the open meetings law is located on the north wall of the legislative chambers and that there is an Automatic External Defibrillator available on the back wall of the legislative chambers.

Motion by Kraft, seconded by Morgan to approve the following:

- A. Approval of the minutes of the Board of Equalization meeting held Tuesday, June 3, 2014.
- B. Call for a meeting and set Tuesday, June 17, 2014, as date for hearing on Certified Assessment Corrections reflecting the addition of omitted property to the tax rolls or increased value on property.

Douglas County Clerk/Comptroller Thomas F. Cavanaugh stated that the vote system was down. Chair Borgeson requested a roll call vote.
